## Eathan F. Allen and his Family - n.d.

Eathan Allen and his wife were the prettiest folks I ever saw and so were their children. Eathan Allen is thirty Mary, his wife is twenty nine, and Jimmy his son is ten, and Alice his daughter is nine. Eathan's folks lived on Big Continent on Bay Point at Picnic City. He is the great president. Eathan Allen, All of the Big Continenters were with war with Long Continent Round Continent and Rock Island. These folks kept trying to capture a part of Big Continent and Eathan Allen kept driveing them back and Jimmy Allen and all the Big Continent boys were haveing war with the Rock Island boys. Then Jimmy began to fire on the Seagull, and in turn fired on Jimmy. Jimmy dashed up, the Seagul turned, and the flag that put back to [wa]rd Jimmy used Rock Island. The [n] he saw the Seagull was sinking and that the Rock Islanders would give up, so captureing them, he fastened one by one to the sail post of the Seagull and struck them three times with a whip, then let them goo [sic]. Just then, out came a large boat from Rock Island and began to fire on Jimmy's men. Jimmy fired back and with powder and [bullets?]. The Rock Islanders were driven back as Jimmy expresed it. all at once Jimmy saw the Rock Islanders makeing a great stur [then the [e]nd of the boat went under and all of the Rock Islanders jumped out of their boat and swam to shore. Then Jimmy sailed back to Granite Fort. That night the Long Continenters made an atack on Granite Fort. Eathan Allen fired on them then Eathen Allen rushed out with two hundred foweler [followers] and with shouts and bangs drove them away from Granite Fort and the flag that Granite Hill Eathan Allen used was aga[i]n restored to peace but instead of going of [f] the Long Continenters made a plot to atack Picnic City the barking of the dogs that belonged to the folks wakened the

inhabertance [inhabitants] Alice and Mary were in the house that Long Islander attacked and Mary took her revolver that Eathan Allen gave her then they fired on Will's party and soo did the rest of the inhabertance [inhabitants] and drove away Will's party. The next day Eathan Allen came home and he said he had the bravest son and daughter and wife in the world. In a few months Eathan Allen moved to Coast Range City whare he apointed to be the Capital and our presided [president] and captain Eathan Allen is liveing thare now.
