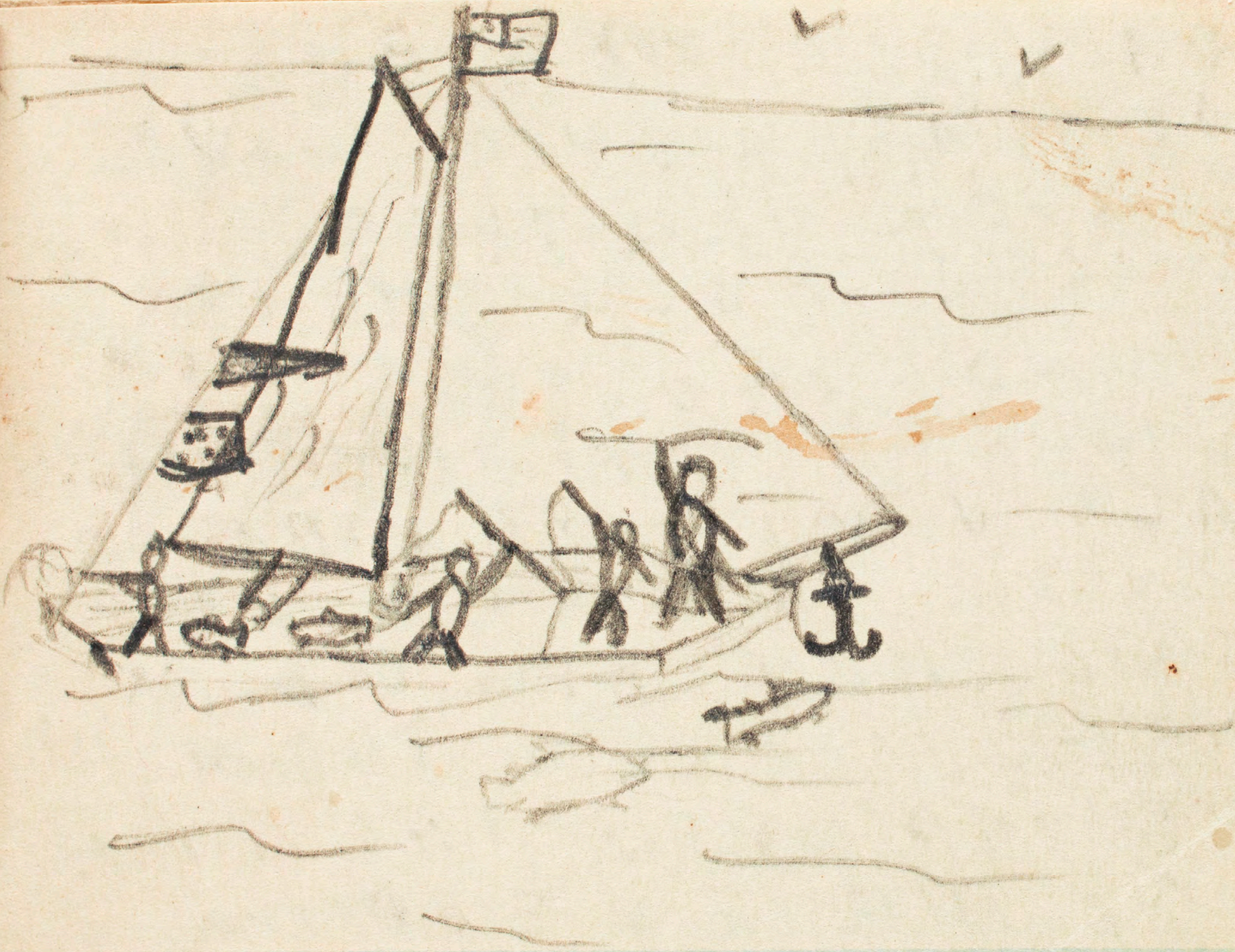


THE VOYAGE OF THREE  
FRANCIS

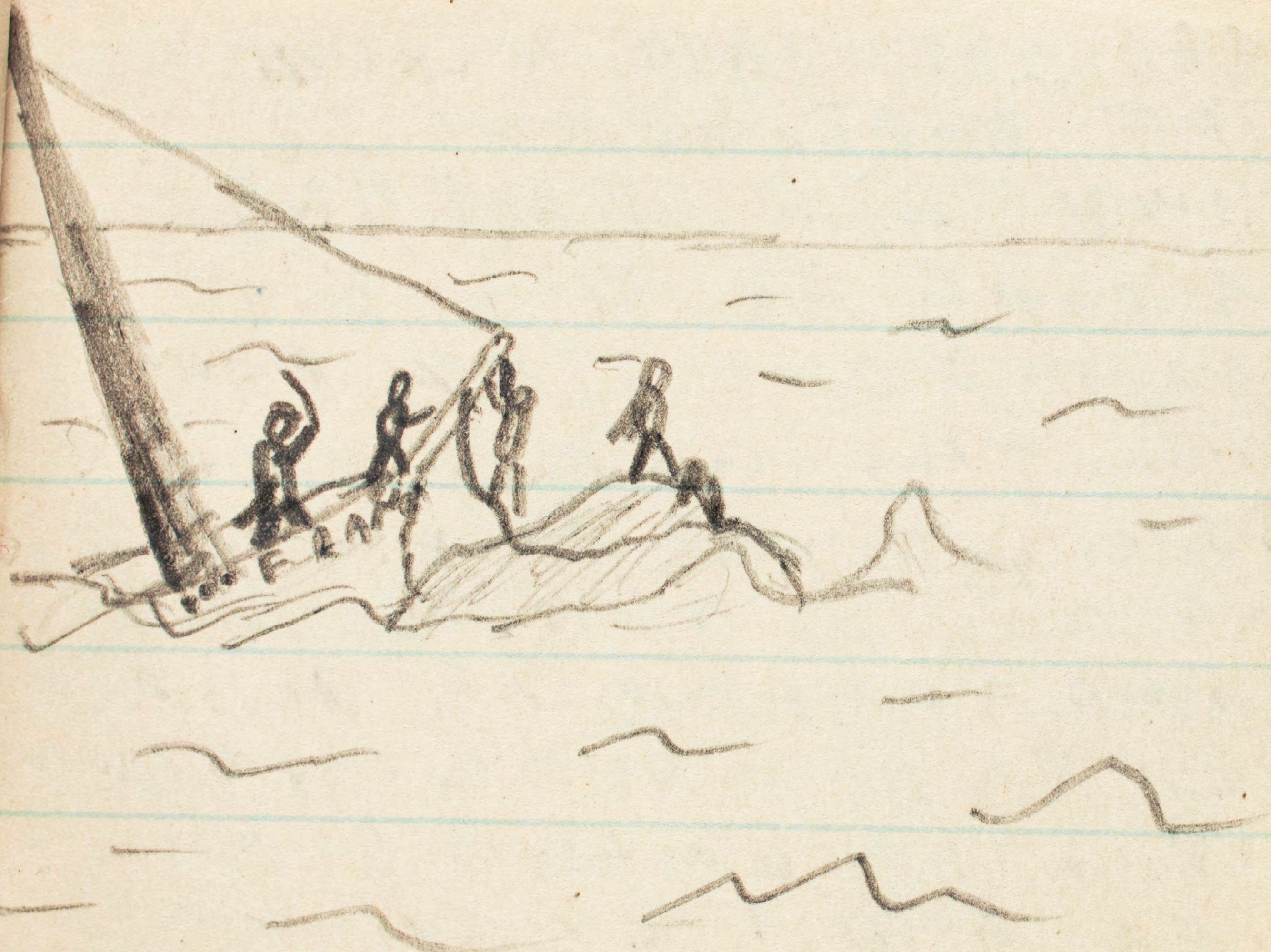
IT WAS EARLY IN JULY WHEN

ABOUT WAVES CAME



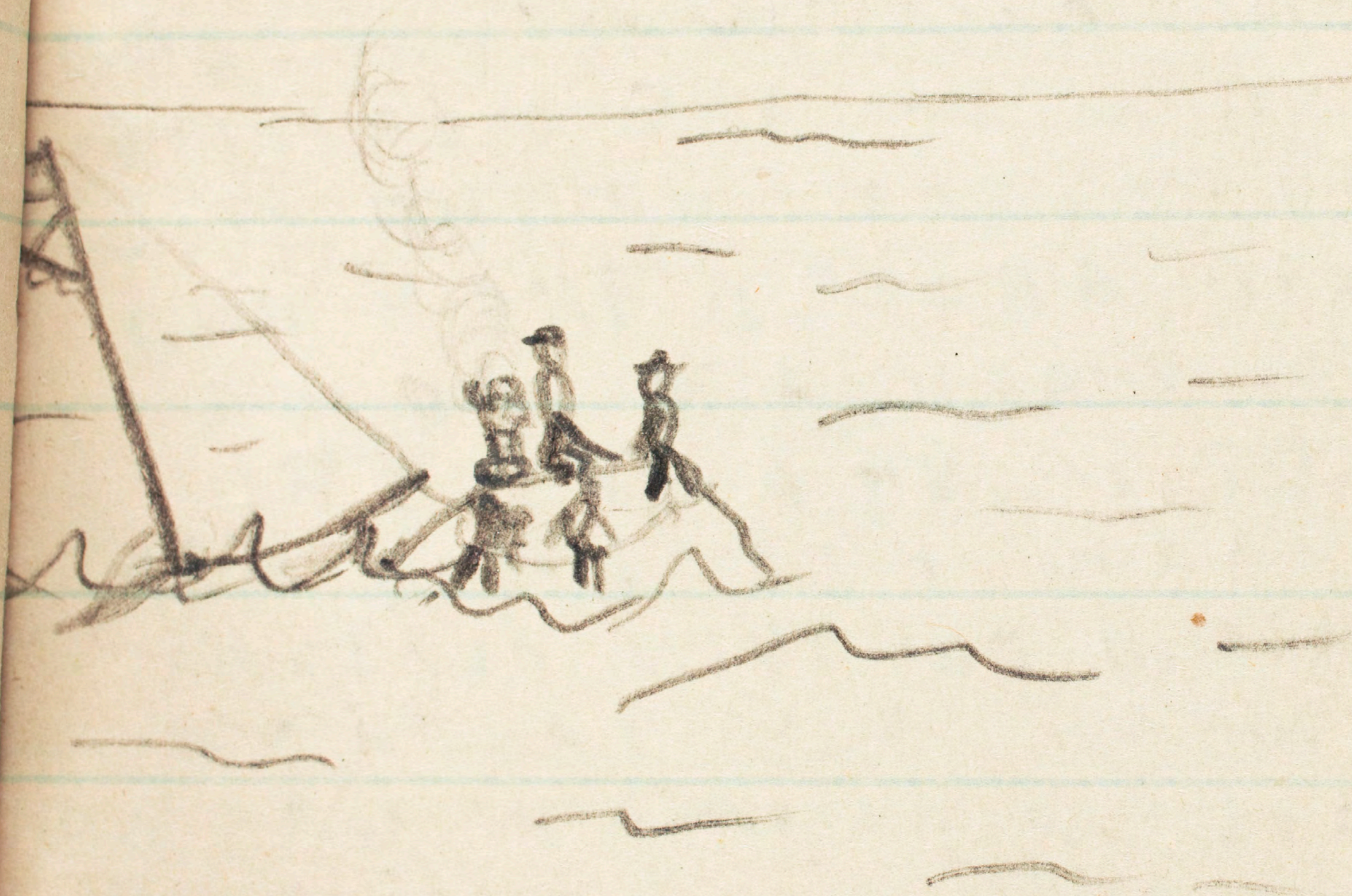
SPEARING SALMON

WRECKED IN THE STORM

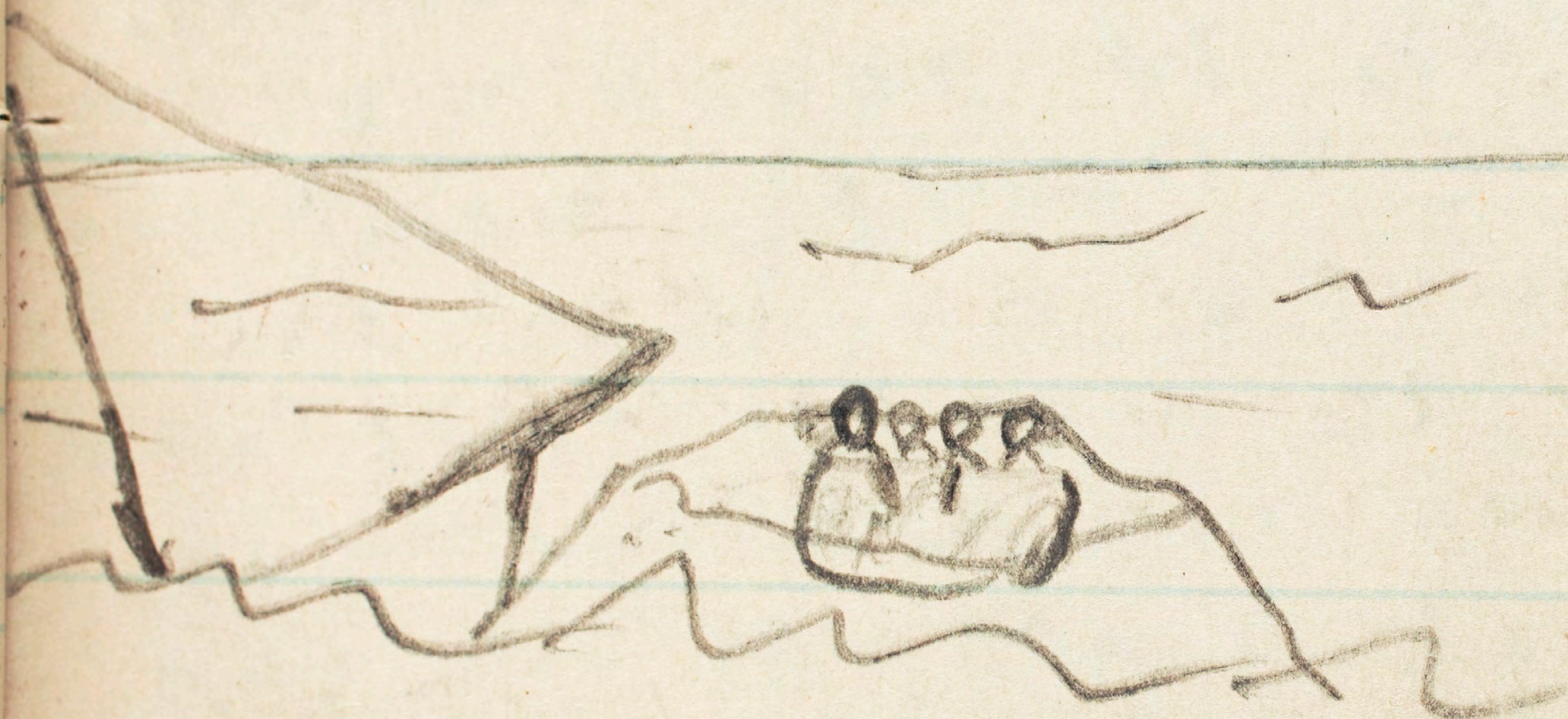
HAD GOT THIS ALL DONE
